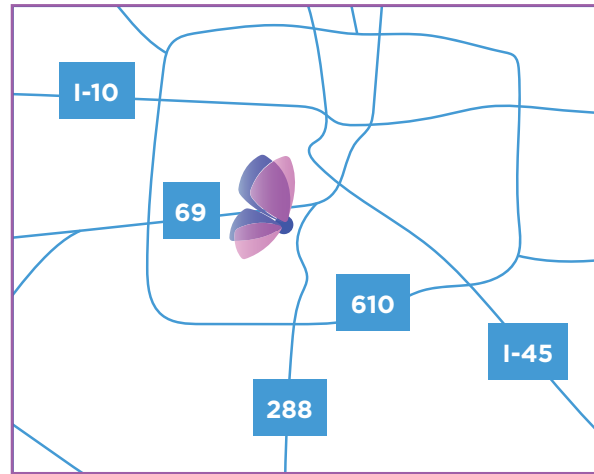


WHAT TO EXPECT AT YOUR FIRST APPOINTMENT

At your initial consultation, our doctor will review your symptoms and medical history and perform a physical examination. They will then review the risks and benefits of the procedure and answer any questions you may have.

Diagnostic imaging may be required to assess the size, number and location of your hemorrhoids, and can help determine whether or not you would be a good candidate for HAE. If you have already received a diagnosis, we recommend bringing any documents or images with you at the time of your appointment.

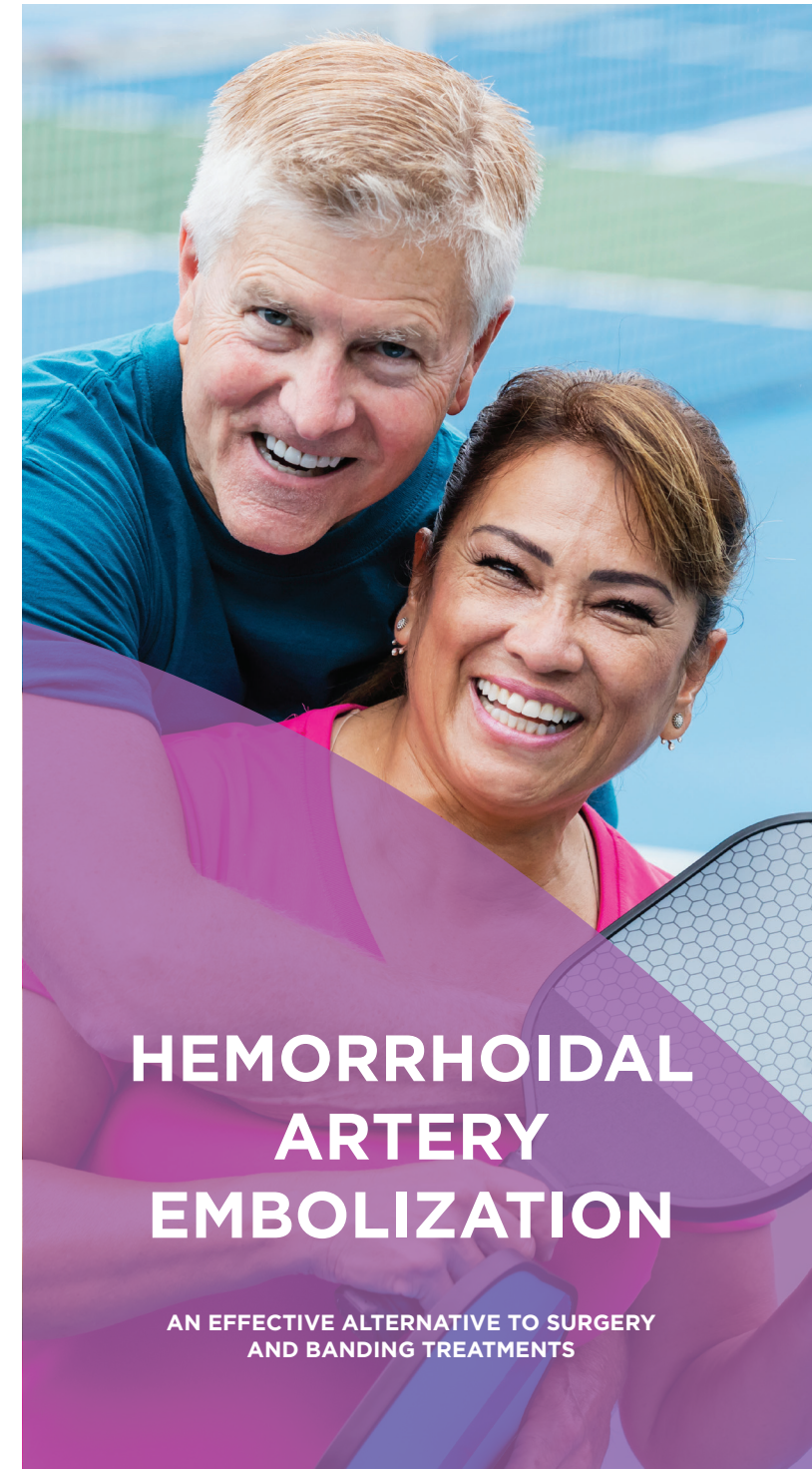

HEMORRHOIDAL ARTERY EMBOLIZATION

WHAT IS HEMORRHOIDAL ARTERY EMBOLIZATION?

Hemorrhoidal artery embolization (HAE) is a minimally invasive, non-surgical alternative to surgery and banding procedures. It is typically recommended for patients with grade 1 to 3 internal hemorrhoids who have not responded to conservative treatment. It is safe and effective,¹ and offers comparable outcomes to surgery, but with less pain.²

HAE is performed by an interventional radiologist who inserts a tiny catheter into an artery in your upper thigh, and then uses x-ray imaging to guide it through the body's blood vessels to the rectal artery. Special coils are inserted into the hemorrhoid to cut off its blood supply, causing it to shrink. Unlike surgery, there is no general anesthesia required for the procedure, no incisions and no painful recovery. You are able to return home the same day and resume your normal activities.
